# PASTOR'S PEN

TENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - JUNE 9, 2024

Our readings today speak loudly about unity in the Body of Christ, that we, the Baptized, comprise the Body of Christ – that we are the Church – not a building that we gather in no matter how holy or beautiful. Jesus warns us of the danger of disunity, of thinking in silos, of not being concerned for others outside of our walls. If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. And if a house is divided against itself, that house will not be able to stand.

Where did disunity begin? In the Garden. In our first reading from Genesis, we see Adam and Eve just after the Fall. God is close to them in the Garden; he literally walks among them "at the time of the evening breeze." Adam and Eve will create a separation, a distance from the God who wishes to be close to them. They (Adam and Eve) hear God walking and are afraid...why? "because I was naked; and I hid myself." Shame comes into the picture. They were never ashamed of being naked before God until sin came into the picture. So, sin causes disunity, and disunity creates a separation from God. Christ comes to heal this shame, disunity, and separation. We are reminded by St. Paul, "so we do not lose heart," because by God's grace, "everything is for your sake," or put another way, "all of this is happening for your good." God desires our salvation, and he desires us to walk in peace in the kingdom, to be without sin or shame, and to know closeness with Him.

I wish to congratulate all those who worked so hard to make our 3rd Annual Family of Parishes Luncheon so successful. To the social committee, to all the volunteers, to the various dancers and musicians, to all those who decorated the school gym – God bless you—events like this help to promote unity among us.

## “Church Etiquette“

We left off talking about the homily; now we move to the creed and the prayers of the faithful, general or universal intercessions or petitions.

The creed is our common profession of faith, there are two that we pray, the Apostles Creed or the Nicene Creed. In the Apostles Creed, we are asked to bow at the words, "who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary." in the Nicene Creed, we are asked to bow at the words, "and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man." On March 25 (Annunciation) and December 25 (Christmas), we genuflect on these words.

This brings us to the prayers of the faithful. These are petitions for the community's and the world's needs; we pray for the suffering and the dead. This concludes the Liturgy of the Word, and now we move into the Liturgy of the Eucharist.

Please keep Fr. Paul, our associate, in your prayers as he has returned to Kenya for the Funerals of His Father and Grandmother. Have a wonderful week ahead of you.
