March 12, 2023 - 3rd Sunday of Lent

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

The woman at the well. This reading from John's Gospel is so rich and is ultimately a model or template for personal conversion.

1. Wells are for water - we need water - deserts are hot, people would congregate around wells - but not at the height of the heat as this woman did - at noon.
2. Why was she alone and not with others? A social outcast - many, many husbands.
3. A Samaritan - enemy of the Jews.
4. Jesus speaks to her - unheard of. He was a Jew asking a woman, and a Samaritan for a drink of water.
5. "...living water" - indoor plumbing? No - living water which Christ is the source.
6. Worshipping in Spirit and truth....not in Jerusalem or Samaria.
7. The messiah, "I am He, the one who is speaking to you." The encounter.
8. "The woman left her water jar and went back to the city". Witnessing, evangelizing.

Many Samaritans from the city believed in Jesus....they came to Him (Jesus). They come themselves - intentional disciples.

This beautiful Gospel displays for us the longing and "thirst" the Lord has for our love, and for our deeper conversion. He wants us to present our "truths" to him - no matter what the situation.
