March 5, 2023 - 2nd Sunday of Lent

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

We had a wonderful turn out for Ash Wednesday Mass at our parishes even though the weather wasn't the greatest. This past Monday all of the staff were on retreat at the Michaelite House in Melrose for a day of prayer, food, and education.

This second Sunday of Lent could be called Transfiguration Sunday for the reading from our Gospel today.

In our first reading from Genesis, Abram is asked to trust God - go in your old age and weakness to a strange land and I will establish a covenant with you. Trust - yes I know it seems impossible but trust. God asked that of Abram, God asks that of us today.

To young Timothy - don't be surprised when you have to suffer because of the Gospel - remember Jesus' words - take up your cross and follow me.

And finally, Jesus takes the "core" of the disciples - Peter, James, and John to Mt. Tabor and is transfigured - seen in glory. This is to prepare them for the scandal of the Cross - Jesus crucified like a common criminal and the seeming end of their dream with and for him. Moses and Elijah - the Law and Prophets - speaks with Jesus - about his upcoming passion in Jerusalem.

Grace is remembering; we remember the moments of consolation during our moments of desolation, our darkness.

So let us continue our Lenten journey - with Jesus.
