Third Sunday of Easter

In our Gospel this Sunday, we encounter weary Apostles going back to their former profession as fishermen. They are wearied by their work, fishing all night with no success. Sometimes we are weary, sometimes we get discouraged by the seeming lack of success. But our Lord calls us to persevere, to throw out our nets again, and to trust.

As a community of welcoming disciples – we need to sit at the feet of the Lord and to be fed. *“We need to educate and form those who have embraced the Gospel so that they can live as disciples of Jesus, preparing all to celebrate the sacraments fully and fruitfully.”*

Jesus prepares breakfast for his weary followers and elicits faith and gives healing to Peter with the simple question, *“Do you love me?”*

Look deep within yourself Peter, *“Do you love me?”* *“Of course you do even with your triple denial, I know you love me – I accept your love Peter.”*

We as a community, as a parish – knowing our mission and calling must “offer on-going evangelization and catechesis, and prepare our people for leadership roles in the Church”.

Knowing we are loved, knowing we are forgiven, we need to “exercise a ministry of love, strengthening our fellow parishioners to live their faith boldly and to share it through witness and outreach to others”. We are called to persevere - in His grace.
