May 21, 2023 - Ascension of the Lord

Dear sisters and brothers,

The Ascension that we celebrate is the victory of Christ over sin and death, and our share in His victory. Many years ago, there was a popular song that went, "please don't let this feeling end..." I had to Google it, it is the theme song from *Ice Castles; Through the Eyes of Love*. Anyway, in some ways this is St. Peter's theme song. Peter (and all the apostles) don't want to let go of the comforting and assuring presence of the Lord. Think back to the Transfiguration event on Mt. Tabor - Peter is the one who suggested that they build three tents; one for Moses, one for Elijah, and one for Jesus, so that the moment of glory could be captured, prolonged — a "kodak" moment (for those who are over 50).

In today's first reading it takes two angels to startle the apostles back to reality. "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking up toward heaven? Don't just stand there "gawking", get back to Jerusalem and wait for the promised gift from heaven, the Holy Spirit." Sometimes we just want to stand gazing towards heaven, day-dreaming, when God wants us to work for the building of the kingdom with the help, inspiration, and strength of the Holy Spirit. Don't "gawk", do something.

On Saturday we began our nine-day novena to the Holy Spirit. Booklets will be provided in English, Spanish, and Croatian (or it will be projected on the weekend). We will pray this novena at all of our Masses (either before or after) until the great Solemnity of Pentecost. Our needs are great, but so is our God. We have a great need of more volunteers for our various ministries, the needs of God's people are great - so I am imploring the Holy Spirit to touch your hearts and show you ways of service and give you the courage to step forward.

All we need to do is say our "YES" to God - and trust that he will provide.
