May 28, 2023 - Pentecost Sunday

Dear sisters and brothers,

The Holy Spirit enables, equips the apostles and us for the work of ministry. Pentecost is the birthday of the church. The psalmist in Psalm 104 cries out, "Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth." This Spirit of the Lord, we come to see first in the second verse of the Book of Genesis, "and a mighty wind swept over the waters", literally, "spirit or breath [ruah] of God". This creative and life-giving force, this second person of the Trinity, the Lord and giver of Life.

The Spirit creates, sustains, and renews. "When you send forth your spirit, they are created, and you renew the face of the earth." No one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit informs and strengthens us. We have the faith to lift our minds and hearts to the Lord by and through the Gift of the Holy Spirit. The Spirit prays with us, in and through us. The Spirit comes to the aid of our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but the Spirit itself intercedes with inexpressible groanings - Romans Ch. 8. So, with the Gift of the Holy Spirit, we pray in the Spirit, we come to God with and in the Spirit – and the Spirit intercedes for us.

In the sequence for today's feast, the Veni Creator Spiritus, we find the verses: "Heal our wounds, our strength renew; On our dryness pour your dew; Wash the stains of guilt away; Bend the stubborn heart and will; Melt the frozen, warm the chill; Guide the steps that go astray." These are apt petitions. Dew on dryness, melt the frozen, warm the chill. You can really see why fire is associated with the Spirit, by whose power frozen hearts are melted, dry and barren souls spring to life.

Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you." Stood in the midst of their fears and apprehensions, and bestowed upon them the gift of peace. In the midst of our locked hearts and fearful minds the Spirit can shed his light and peace.

He (Jesus) breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained." Jesus gives the Holy Spirit to the apostles and then charges them to bring mercy to God's people. To spread the gospel of Mercy, the good news to all people.

As disciples of the Lord, filled with the Spirit, let us call upon this Holy Spirit in our daily lives. Let the wisdom and courage of the Spirit enable us to be bolder proclaimers of the Good News to our world.
