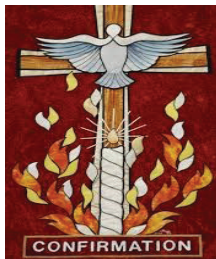

May 7, 2023 - Fifth Sunday of Easter

Dear Friends,

Are you a worrier? Do you find yourself either remembering the past with regret or looking to the future with anxiety? Jesus has the perfect prescription for your anxieties – TRUST! TRUST HIM!

We don't trust Him because we are unsure of His love and providential care for us. "A Just in Case" approach is not helpful either. In reality, we are not in control, and our worries do not add a day or minute to our lives.

Jesus gives a command to His disciples the night before His own death. Here Jesus is about to go into the Garden of Gethsemane, to sweat blood and take upon himself the sins of the world, and what does he say to his disciples? "Do not let your hearts be troubled. You have faith in God; have faith also in me." This was not a suggestion of the Lord, a good idea of the Lord, a "bon mot" of the Lord – it is a commandment! "Do not let your hearts be troubled." Why do we allow ourselves to be robbed of the inner peace that Christ wishes us to live out of by our doubts and fears?

Either Jesus is telling us the truth, or he is lying to us; there is no middle ground. And if he is telling the truth, then we must cast our fears and worries over to Him. He is either the Savior or He is not. "Truly I tell you, unless you change and become like children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven." (Matthew 18) Jesus wants from us the perfect trust that a child has for its parent. Jesus wants us to pray for this grace if we do not have it, and He will give it to us, He will teach us to trust.

"In my Father's house there are many dwelling places. I am going to prepare a place for you. I will come back again and will take you to myself." Would it give you comfort to know that in Florida that there was a condo with your name on it – all paid up – no condo fees – all yours! All you have to do is get there.

We have a place prepared for us in the Kingdom, your name is on a door, a welcome awaits. What are we so afraid of?

Yes, death is scary, so is pain and suffering but Jesus went through it first for us, and promises to shepherd us through our share of his passion, death, and resurrection.

Have courage and trust in the Lord!
