PASTOR'S PEN

32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time - November 10, 2024

As we now move into the month of November we are called on to “remember.” Remembering is an essential aspect to our Christian life. Enshrined in the canon of the Mass we hear the command of the Lord, “do this in memory of me.” The act of remembering is sacred. God called the children of Israel to remember all of the marvelous deeds He had done for them and especially to remember his covenant love expressed to them over and over again.

In the liturgical calendar of this month there are feasts and days which call us to remember. On November the first, we celebrated All Saints Day, a day which we commemorate all who have been examples of faith to us. This day is not only for those who have been officially canonized saints by the Church, but for the countless number of men and women and children who stand face to face before God and enjoy the fullness of His life and love – our mothers and fathers, our sisters and brothers, our relatives and friends.

On November the second, we turned our thoughts to praying for our deceased brothers and sisters on All Souls Day. As Christians we remember our dead with love and assist them by our prayers. The theological underpinnings of purgatory speak to us of “capacity.” The capacity needed to accept the fullness of God’s love and mercy in the beatific vision – God’s presence face to face. We can think of purgatory as a place or process, a “school of love” where a soul is “expanded” from the selfishness and “smallness” which sin creates to be able to take in the fullness of God’s love. There are purgative elements in our daily lives along with God’s grace which help us with this as well.

The Church believes that our prayers and sacrifices (most importantly the perfect sacrifice of the Mass) offered for the souls in purgatory assist them in this process of expansion one may say. Then because of the Communion of Saints they too will pray and intercede for us before the throne of God when they see God face to face. What a wonderful economy of grace!

On the eleventh day of the eleventh month at the eleventh hour – we remember. On Remembrance Day we stop to give thanks to God for our freedoms and to remember the many brave women and men who fought for our freedoms. We also remember all who were killed during the wars and battles of the past.

“Lest we forget.” To not remember our past, no matter how painful at times, is to be doomed to repeat it. Especially at this present time let us pray for peace in the Holy Land and the Ukraine.

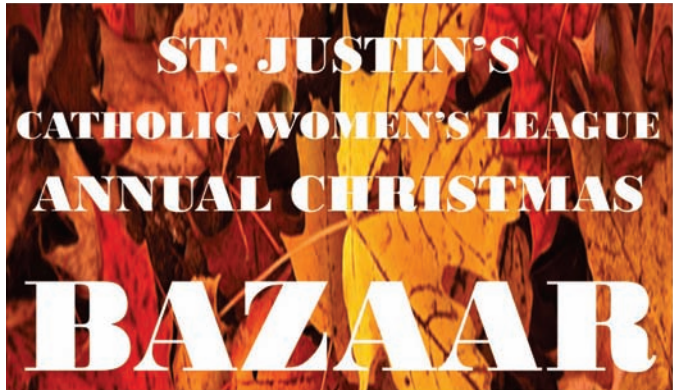
