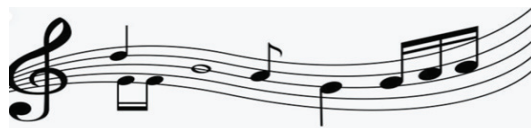

## *November 20, 2022 - Feast of Christ the King*

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Solemnity of Christ the King

Now the Kingship that Christ models for us is quite different from an earthly monarch. There have been good Kings and Queens, righteous monarchs in history. Melchizedek, mentioned in Genesis, King of Salem and Priest of the Most High, David, Shepherd King of Israel, and Solomon, his Son (though he went off the rails at the end). Lots of good kings of Judah, (lots of bad kings in Israel) – Good Christian Monarchs, Stephen of Hungary, Wenceslaus, Louis of France, etc. But all of these as good as they have been were given their goodness from outside themselves – from God. Christ the King, meek and humble, is the Son of God.

Jesus on the throne of the cross is presented to us today to starkly remind us of the type of Kingship he exercises. Scoffed at by some of the Jewish leaders gathered at his cross, scorned by the Roman soldiers, Jesus crucified hardly looks like any earthly king. No power, no splendor, only weakness and fidelity can we see. Crucified between two criminals – Jesus takes on himself, the sin of the world – our sin – every sin. This is our King, our great sin-bearer.

Even in the midst of His own agony – Jesus is anxious to save – to show mercy. One of the criminals turns to Jesus – aware of his own sin and the justice of his punishment – and cries, “Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom.” In that last moment He is saved. This is our King – this is our Lord.

Remember that Advent starts next Sunday - get your advent wreathes at home ready! I will be away on retreat from Sunday afternoon November 20<sup>th</sup> until next Saturday morning - I will see you on the weekend.
