**Solemnity of Our Lord, King of the Universe  
November 24, 2024**

Now the Kingship that Christ models for us is quite different from an earthly monarch. There have been good Kings and Queens, righteous monarchs in history; Melchizedek mentioned in Genesis, King of Salem and Priest of the Most High, David Shepherd King of Israel and Solomon his Son (though he went off the rails at the end). Lots of good kings of Judah, (lots of bad kings in Israel) – Good Christian Monarchs; Stephen of Hungary, Wenceslaus, Louis of France, etc. But all these as good as they were, have been given their goodness from outside themselves – from God. Christ the King, meek and humble, is the Son of God. In today's Gospel according to John, we see Him before Pontius Pilate, Pilate the Roman, Pilate the pagan, the cynic. Above all this Jewish mysticism, he cuts to what he thinks is at the heart of this situation, this trial. "Are you the King of the Jews?" Are you a real threat to the Emperor's temporal authority and power? Are you a threat to me?

When we do submit to God, and we do it again and again and again, we begin to see that we lose nothing and as a matter of fact, we become more than we ever thought possible.

Jesus answered Pilate, "My kingdom does not belong to this world...." The embrace, the impact of this Kingdom goes beyond walls and borders, maps, and territories, even beyond time and space. It penetrates minds, hearts, and souls and has no limits. Here this Jesus, beaten and humiliated – our King – stands before the Pilate's of the world (sneering and grinning) and reveals truth. Every dictator, every tyrant, every regime that has ever existed or will exist that denies or would deny Christ's authority, stood there with Pilate that Good Friday morning and were condemned before the Truth. And what does accepting the Truth, the Authority of Christ the King entail for us ... Freedom (not license) but true freedom, liberation. "And the truth will set you free.... Hail Christ our King."

I received a letter from Bishop Fabbro granting the parishes of St. Francis-St. Martin and St. Leopold Mandic within our Family of Parishes, permission to have intentions at their Vigil and Sunday Masses. There is to be no more than six intentions at any of these Masses. This permission will last until Dec. 31, 2026, and will then need to be re-applied for. This will begin at these parishes on Nov. 30, 2024.

Also, congratulations to our Spanish community on their Gala Dinner – thank you for all your efforts to support your parish.
