November 5th - 31st Sunday in Ordinary Time

“Whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and whoever humbles himself will be exalted.” Humility – humility the greatest of all the virtues and the antidote, the medicine to the worst of all sins, pride. What is humility? I think many people have a false or incorrect notion of what humility is. Let us start by showing what humility is not. Humility is not putting oneself down. Humility is not letting someone use or abuse you – humility is not becoming a human door mat.

Humility (by God’s grace) is knowing who you are, who God is, and who your neighbour is.

Who am I: a child of God, redeemed by God’s grace, a sinner in need of repentance and utterly dependent on God.

Who is God: my loving Father, Redeemer, and Sanctifier. My Creator and Redeemer.

Who is my neighbour: all my Brothers and Sisters, made in the image and likeness of God, loved by God into being as I am. My equal before God, who I must love.

True humility is knowing in the mind and heart how profoundly we are loved by God, and with this grace, moved beyond ourselves to the “other”. The humble also have a profound sense of absolute dependency on God – trust in God, childlike trust in God.

None of us lives up to the Gospel perfectly, we all fall short. The preacher is not equal to the Gospel he preaches – but we all try with God’s grace. True humility keeps us from usurping from God the one right that he has withheld from humankind – that of judgement. We cannot judge our sisters or brothers.
