32nd Sunday Year B

Have you ever had the experience of pouring all of yourself into something you had to do, whether that be a project for school, an assignment at work – or even more importantly into a relationship with someone.

It takes a great deal of strength and an equal amount of trust to do this – it's an investment of our time, treasure and talent. And we go forward hoping that it will pay off, a good mark at school, a promotion at work – a lasting relationship with another.

If we look at our readings from Sacred Scripture this weekend we see two women, one the widow of Zarephath and another a poor widow in the temple. Both of these women were asked to trust – basically to place their lives and their future into God's hands – and that's not easy – it required of them an act of faith.

The Widow of Zarephath - There can be a tendency in our lives when we feel threatened, or when there is a scarcity or a shortage, to hoard, to cling on to, as if we can control the future. God provided generously for this widow and her son when they gave freely and trusted that God could do what seemed to be impossible. If they would have clung to the handful of flour and the little oil – they would have starved to death – starved to death by depending on their own strengths, relying on themselves and not God.

Are we in danger of starving to death ? Who do we rely on ?

Jesus and the Poor Widow - And he notices two types of people, those who are rich and self-sufficient and a poor widow – one of the most vulnerable class of people in the time of Jesus.

This poor widow comes and gives her two small coins – which in the eyes of most would be a pittance. But for her it was all she had – she is giving out of her poverty – she is trusting that this gift, this sacrifice given in faith to God will be honored and God will provide. Wow, this is deep faith. I have no doubt whatsoever that God provide for her all her days.

So, at what level do we trust God to provide for us. I'm not saying it is bad to plan, quite the opposite, planning is wise. But what is the foundation of our choices of our plans, what lays below our choices in life?
