Wisdom: "I prayed, and understanding was given me; I entreated, and the spirit of Wisdom came to me. I esteemed her more than scepters and thrones; compared with her; I held riches as nothing."

To know, to be able to discern the true value of someone or something is a gift of the Spirit. Oscar Wilde once said, "the cynic knows the cost of everything but the value of nothing."

Through prayer and discernment, we know 1) The shortness of life - the value of time. 2) The value of Eternal Life and 3) How to achieve it? For Humans it is impossible, but for God everything is possible.
