RED MASS-ST. PETER'S CATHEDRAL BASILICA

A Red Mass is an annual event for the legal profession, including judges, lawyers, and law students, marking the judicial year's opening. It seeks guidance from the Holy Spirit and encourages reflection on the responsibilities of legal professionals. Originating in 13th-century Europe, the first recorded Red Mass was in Paris in 1245, later spreading to North America, with the first Canadian Mass in Quebec City in 1896. This year, the Red Mass will be held at St. Peter's Cathedral Basilica on October 29th, seeking divine guidance for justice administration. All are welcome to attend.
