October 8th - 27th Sunday in Ordinary Time

We are expected to produce! In today's parable the Father lends His vineyard out and sends slaves that are mistreated and killed to collect his produce at the appointed time. Then the sentence that always moves me is, "Surely they will respect my Son." In this parable Jesus is the Son that is sent. "They seized him, threw him out of the vineyard, and killed him." Outside of the walls Jesus is crucified - outside of the vineyard, Jerusalem, lovingly planted by the Father.

Jesus then asks the hearers of this parable, "What will he (the Father) do to those tenants?" He will punish these tenants and give the vineyard to others who will produce at the Harvest time.

Are we good stewards of what God has given us? Could we lose what the Lord has given us, and others be given our share of the vineyard who would be better stewards than we? Questions for us to ponder in prayer.

It is good to be home! I have travelled throughout Quebec in August during our pilgrimage of the Shrines and September in Israel, Jordan, and Palestine (the West Bank). There were many moving sights and experiences, but also, I was struck by the poverty and struggle that so many of our brothers and sisters live with on a daily basis.

I remembered you in my Masses and prayers at the sites of the Annunciation, the Nativity, the Garden of Gethsemane, and the Holy Sepulcher, just to name a few.

We are heading into cold and flu season. I have asked that we have available, should you choose to use them, masks at the entrances of our churches. I have also asked that our Eucharistic Ministers and priests wear masks while they distribute Holy Communion.

Let's help one another be safe and healthy!
