### The Story of Saint Padre Pio

St. Padre Pio was born Francesco Forgione on May 25, 1887, in Pietrelcina and died September 23, 1968, San Giovanni Rotondo, Italy. He was also known as Saint Pius of Pietrelcina — he was canonized June 16, 2002. His feast day is September 23.

St. Padre Pio's parents were peasant farmers. He had an older brother and three younger sisters, as well as two other siblings who died in infancy. As a child, he was very religious and by the age of five he reportedly made the decision to dedicate his life to God. His family attended daily Mass with Francisco serving as an altar boy at his local parish. From a young age, he had a peculiar ability of seeing guardian angels, and speaking with Jesus and the Virgin Mary. At 15, he entered the novitiate of the Capuchin friars, taking on the name of "Pio" in honour of Pope Pius I. Despite his ongoing illnesses he continued to study for the priesthood. Despite frail health throughout his studies, the young Pio persevered being ordained as a priest in 1910.

On Friday, Sept. 20, 1918, while he was praying before a crucifix and making his thanksgiving after Mass, the marks of the stigmata, the wounds of Christ, appeared on Padre Pio's body. He was thirty-one years old and became the first stigmatized priest in the history of the Church. With resignation and serenity, he bore the painful wounds in his hands, feet, and side for fifty years.

In addition, God endowed Padre Pio with many extraordinary gifts and charisms in healing, bilocation, prophecy, miracles, discernment of spirits, the ability to read hearts, the gift of tongues (ability to speak and understand languages that he had never studied), gift of conversions, and the fragrance which emanated from his wounds and which frequently announced his invisible presence.

He is revered as a man of charity and piety. He is known as the patron saint of civil defense volunteers, adolescents, and stress-relief.



## *25th Sunday in Ordinary Time*

“No servant can serve two masters”. In the trilogy of JRR Tolkien’s, *The Lord of the Rings*, Gollum or Sméagol, a Hobbit, is presented as a good example of a creature that is tortured – in conflict – because he tries to serve two masters, but eventually only one can take hold of him. “He creeps across Middle-earth in secret, perpetually hunting in the darkness for his precious .... the Ring”. The Ring is the Ring of Power. To Bilbo Bagins he says, “We want it, we needs it. Must have the precious. They stole it from us. Sneaky little hobbitses. Wicked, tricky, false!” All that matters to Gollum is the possession of the ring. Ultimately his overriding desire for the ring will kill him.

We are warned in our readings this Sunday of the destructive power, allure of the love or desire for money and power.
