**100 YEAR JUBILEE OF THE CONGREGATION OF
ST. MICHAEL THE ARCHANGEL**

The Congregation of St. Michael the Archangel, known as the Michaelite Fathers, are celebrating the 100 Year Jubilee of their official recognition by the Church.

A Mass of Thanksgiving will be celebrated at St. Peter's Cathedral Basilica in London on Sunday, September 26 at 4:00 p.m. The presider of this Mass will be Most Rev. Ronald P. Fabbro, CSB, Bishop of London and the homilist will be Most Rev. Joseph Dabrowski, C.S.M.A., Auxiliary Bishop of London. Concelebrating will be the priests of the Michaelite Fathers ministering in North America. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, attendance at this celebration will be by invitation only, but a livestream from the cathedral is planned. Please keep in your prayers all the members of The Michaelite Fathers Religious community ministering here and around the world. Blessed Bronislaw Markiewicz, founder of this Congregation, pray for us!
