VOCATIONS SUNDAY

Currently the diocese has 4 seminarians studying for the priesthood: KEVIN BURGESS, MARC GAUDET, STEVEN GAUDET and FRANCIS LEROUX. Three are currently studying at St. Peter's Seminary in London, Ontario, and one is studying at the Grand Séminaire de Montréal. The time of studies takes between 5 and 8 years depending on what level of post secondary education has been completed. Many programs include one year of experience in a parish. It costs between \$18,000 to \$22,000 a year for each seminarian, which the diocese pays from the Vocation's collection. Please pray for our seminarians and we thank you for supporting this year's collection which will be the weekend of 6 and 7 May.

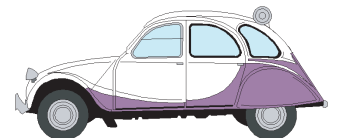
