LEADERSHIP WEEKEND FOR TEENS IN GRADES 9-12

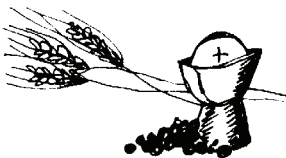

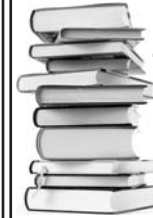

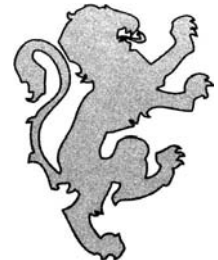
