DEVELOPMENT & PEACE

Peasants or small-scale farmers are an essential piece of the global food system, especially, though not only, for people in the Global South. Despite their indispensable role in feeding people, peasant farmers face unique challenges. For example, a group of farmers might suddenly discover their lands are poisoned by waste from a nearby gold mine, but without financial resources they are unable to hold the mine accountable in court. Or a region long known for growing a particular crop might find that increased flooding or drought caused by climate change means local farmers need to change **what** they plant and **how**. In solidarity with them, we will call on Canada to adopt mandatory human rights and environment due diligence legislation, so that no Canadian company can trample on their rights.
