PRIESTS' PENSION PLAN

Some highlights of the information we had provided last year are listed below. We have 29 priests incardinated in our diocese including 2 past bishops and our current bishop.

- (a) 18 of our priests (64%) are over 65 years of age and are currently receiving a pension.
- (b) 4 of the priests incardinated in the diocese are over age 65 and are in charge of one or more parishes.
- (c) 8 of the priests incardinated in the diocese are under age 65 and are in charge of one or more parishes.
- (d) Our active priests receive a modest salary of \$34,920 per year from which they pay rent to the parish, maintain an automobile and look after other personal living expenses.
