Suggested guidelines from our Archdiocese

As we are in flu season, we want to ensure that our parishes remain safe and welcoming places for worship.

1. Stay Home if sick: Encourage anyone feeling unwell, especially with flu-like symptoms, to refrain from attending Mass or parish events until they are fully recovered. Being sick is a valid reason for missing Mass.
2. Pastoral Care: If someone cannot attend Mass due to illness, encourage them to participate via livestream if available and arrange for Communion to be brought to them if appropriate.
3. Hand Hygiene: Provide hand sanitizer at church entrances and encourage frequent handwashing.
4. Sign of Peace: Remind parishioners that a simple bow or verbal greeting is an acceptable alternative to a handshake during the Sign of Peace.

Reception of Holy Communion: Parishioners who are concerned about illness may receive Communion in the hand rather than on the tongue. Ministers are sanitizing their hands before and after distributing Communion.
