OUR LADY OF FATIMA

This year marks the 100th anniversary of the apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary to three children in Fatima, Portugal. On Saturday, May 13, a crowning of Our Lady of Fatima will occur at the start of the 5:00 pm Mass during which a statue will be placed in the grotto near the confessional. A plenary indulgence may be obtained by visiting the statue that day to pray an "Our Father" and "Creed"; recite a prayer to Our Lady of Fatima; be detached from sin; go to Confession and take Communion within 20 days before or after the day the indulgence is sought; and say a prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father. In honour of the anniversary, prayer cards will be available at both entrances after each Mass this weekend. As well, children's books will be distributed at the side entrance and during the 10:30 am Children's Liturgy class.
