Building Mortgage Fund Collection Report

Our collections to pay the mortgage are declining. In 2016 they did not meet the monthly mortgage payment of \$4,289 for 6 of the 12 months. So far in 2017 the collections did not meet the mortgage payment for the last 3 out of 4 months. April 2016 we were short \$235.84; April 2017 we are short \$1,626.59 so far. In order to meet our mortgage commitments we have had to divert funds from our operational budget, which may impact services and functions the parish provides.
