Confirmation & First Communion

Registration: A meeting for parents of all children eligible for First Communion or Confirmation in this school year will be held next **Sunday**, **Dec. 3rd** in the church. For **First Communion at 1:00pm** and for **Confirmation at 2:00pm**. For parents who cannot make this date there will be a joint makeup Registration and Orientation meeting in the church on **Wednesday**, **Dec. 6th at 7:00pm**. One parent needs to attend, children do not. Please bring a copy of the child's **baptismal certificate**. Due to costs incurred by the parish for Confirmation preparation there will be a <u>fee</u> at the time of registration <u>for Confirmation only</u>. It will be \$20 (cash or cheque). If this is problematic please speak with Fr Lindsay.

This puts a strain on our limited volunteers and personnel.
