Collection of Eyeglasses and Can Tabs

The Catholic Women's League is once again collecting used eyeglasses and aluminum can tabs. Kindly deposit the glasses and can tabs in the marked box located on the CWL shelf in the glass house. The collection will be in effect until December 1, 2019. We had a very successful campaign over the last two years and hope to do the same this year. The CWL thanks you for your contributions.

Where do they go?

- 1) **The aluminum tabs** are taken to Clifford Bowey School near Bank and Walkley roads in Ottawa. This Ottawa Public School serves students with severe developmental disabilities. The school sells the aluminum by weight and the funds go towards purchasing equipment and supplies for their students. The school appreciates the generosity of so many of our CWL volunteers.
- 2) **The eyeglasses** are collected and given to a local optometrist who then forwards the glasses to Medical Ministry International Canada, Stoney Creek, Ontario free of charge. This organization has been serving people for over 47 years. The teams of ophthalmologists, optometrists, doctors, nurses and team members travel to developing countries to provide services to those needing vision care and other illnesses.
