Roof Repairs: Jorgensen has been contracted to renovate several roofs. The remaining two sections of the rectory roof, that were last shingled in 1997, have been re-shingled. The flat roof of the office area, constructed in 1980, has been renovated. New membrane has been installed, a section being sloped to provide better water drainage. The slight parapet of the original roof has been removed, again to allow better drainage.

Renovation of the three roofs at the front of the church is included in the contract. These are the flat-roof extension from the Glass House, the flat roof at the base of the steeple and two v-shaped crevices within the steeple.

The cost of these renovations is \$35,300 + HST. However, Jorgensen has applied a credit of \$5,000 to cover the rain-ingress issue that occurred last year during the renovation of the church roof. *Building & Grounds Sub-Committee*.
