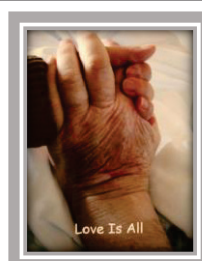
Archdiocese of Ottawa-Cornwall Indigenous Reconciliation Fund Special Collection Nov. 5th/6th
