#### Where do they go?

1) **The aluminum tabs** are taken to Clifford Bowey School on Kitchener Avenue in Ottawa. This Ottawa Public School serves students with developmental disabilities. The school sells the aluminum by weight and the funds go towards purchasing equipment and supplies for their students. The school appreciates the generosity of so many of our parishioners.

2) **The eyeglasses** are collected and delivered to a local optometrist who then forwards the glasses to Medical Ministry International Canada. Over the last 50 years, this organization has provided spiritual and medical care assistance to developing countries around the world - all provided by teams of medical volunteers.
