ADVENT • CHRISTMAS • EPIPHANY

On this Second DAY OF THE LORD of Advent, we are called to **prepare** ourselves during this week to be more open to God's promise that **merciful justice will bring joy**. Being prepared to experience mercy is proclaimed to the exiled people longing to return to Jerusalem, to the Philippians from the imprisoned Paul, to those caught in political turmoil during Jesus' lifetime. In our time we hear voices all around us longing to experience hope and mercy.



Pope Francis has called for a Year of Mercy beginning on December 8th, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception of Mary. This extraordinary grace of God for Mary prepared her to be the Mother of God. Through her act of faith Mary accepted to prepare for the coming of Jesus into the world. He would bring the hope of God's merciful justice for all of us. Like Mary, we are called during the Advent season to prepare ourselves by prayer and

POPE FRANCIS IN CENTRAL AFRICAN REPUBLIC

Pope Francis concluded his tour of Africa on Monday with a forceful call for Christians and Muslims to unite against religious violence in this war-torn country and by urging Catholics to be "artisans of peace" who renounce vengeance for past wrongs. Speaking in an inter-religious meeting with some 200 Muslims at a Bangui's central Mosque, located in an area of the city known for frequent violent inter-religious clashes, Francis exhorted: "Christians and Muslims are brothers and sisters!

We must therefore consider ourselves and conduct ourselves as such. Those who claim to believe in God must also be men and women of peace! Together, we must say no to hatred, to revenge and to violence, particularly that violence which is perpetrated in the name of a religion or of God himself -- God is peace, *salam*," he said, using the Arabic word for peace.
