

THE VICTORIOUS SERVANT OF GOD REIGNS Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ

This celebration of the Body and Blood of Christ is given to us to remind us that the great gift of the Eucharist is a holy mystery. This is Jesus, present in a way beyond our understanding. We take Him into ourselves when we receive communion. We are united to Him sacrificing Himself on the Cross for each of us and all of us when we pray the Mass in its fullness and eat the Sacred Meal. We come before His Presence whenever we are in a sanctuary where the Eucharist is reposed in a tabernacle. The Reserved Presence is a reminder that the Christ is present always with us as we await the Parousia [Second Coming in Glory]. The reserved presence is a foretaste of the Final Resurrection. He was present with the Father and the Spirit at the creation of the universe. He is present with the angels and saints in heaven. He is present here in the Blessed Sacrament. And we take the Holy Presence into ourselves. Today, we thank God for the gift of the Eucharist, and we ask Him to help us grow in reverence for this great sacrament. *Msar. Joe Pellegrino and Fr. ST. RAPHAEL GREEN CORNER Happy Father's Day to all fathers! Tuesday June 21st is National Aboriginal Day! Pope Francis writes;

"It is essential to show special care for indigenous communities and their cultural traditions. They are not merely one minority among others, but should be the principal dialogue partners, especially when large projects affecting their land are proposed. For them, land is not a commodity but rather a gift from God and from their ancestors who rest there, a sacred space with which they need to interact if they are to maintain their identity and values. When they remain on their land, they themselves care for it best." Laudato Si #146

On this day we celebrate and recognize the unique heritage and diverse cultures and outstanding contributions of the First Nations, Inuit and Metis peoples of Canada! Our Indigenous People have cultural traditions that enrich all Canadians. The Indigenous People have a deep connection and reverence for their land as a gift of the Creator! June 21st was chosen because of Indigenous views about the spiritual significance of the year's longest day, the Summer Solstice. Last year's Truth and Reconciliation Commission Report, (TRC) provides "94 Calls to Action" that exhorts Canadians to deal truthfully with a past marred by the horrendous consequences of removing Aboriginal Children from their families in order to assimilate them into the Canadian "way of life". We must become more knowledgeable about our past Canadian history and dialogue with our Indigenous people in order to come to an acceptance of the wrongs and transgressions that occurred, so that we might be part of the reconciliation process that we all must experience! Did you know in the Northwest Territories June 21st, National Aboriginal Day, is observed as a statutory holiday? National Aboriginal day was announced in 1996 by then Governor General of Canada, Roméo Le Blanc. Find out about the celebration of this day! https://www.aadnc-

PARENTING TIP OF THE MONTH: Children thrive on routine and schedules, as do most adults. As summer approaches and the days grow longer, it can be difficult to keep established timetables in check. Helping your children flourish in mind, body and spirit this summer is possible, but as parents you must take control. Keep track of the nutritional value of the food your children consume each day; work hard to be sure they get the proper amount of sleep since it will provide benefits both now and into the future; remember to celebrate God's beauty in nature, to say prayers at meals & before bed and to attend Mass as a family. Children's growth doesn't take a break during the summer months, so be vigilant and they will blossom.



MARRIAGE TIP OF THE MONTH: We live in a time of digital distractions: have you set boundaries around how you will prevent smartphones, tablets and other devices from impacting your life? Their interference has become so prevalent that researchers now have a term to describe it, "technoference," and it is real. How can you take control and decrease the negative impact: limit the amount of time you spend on and checking devices; make rules about digital use during time together; agree on when devices will be prohibited (at meals, on a date, in bed) and stick to it.
