On June 17<sup>th</sup>, we celebrated "*World Day to Combat Desertification.*"

Scientists estimate that there are at least 8 million species of plants and animals living on earth today, including humans. These species all live together in what are called "ecosystems." An ecosystem is a geographic area in which a diverse array of plants, animals, and other organisms coexist together. Ecosystems can be as large as a desert or as small as a pond, and contain living things and nonliving things, like rocks, sand, and humidity. Every piece of an ecosystem depends on the others like a jigsaw puzzle. For instance, a change in the temperature of an ecosystem will have effects on other things, like what plants and animals can grow and live there. The whole surface of Earth is a series of connected ecosystems, from oceans to peatlands to deserts. Often, distant ecosystems rely on each other in unexpected ways. For example, each year the Amazon Rainforest is fertilized from phosphorous contained in around 22 thousand tons of dust carried by the wind from the Sahara Desert thousands of miles away. There has never been a more urgent need to

## away. There has never been a more urgent need to revive damaged ecosystems than now!

Ecosystems support all life on Earth. The healthier our ecosystems are, the healthier the planet - and it's people. The UN Decade on Ecosystem Restoration aims to prevent, halt, and reverse the degradation of ecosystems on every continent and in every ocean. Ecosystem Restoration can help to end poverty, combat climate change, and prevent a mass extinction. It will only succeed if everyone plays a part.
