

THE VICTORIOUS SERVANT OF GOD REIGNS PENTECOST

Today brings us to the end of the 50 days of Easter with the celebration of Pentecost. It should still be clear that Easter is not yet over. We are still celebrating the Resurrection. It is important to remember that the Spirit has not been absent from the Easter story all along. While we find it necessary and helpful to distinguish the role of the three persons of the Trinity, none ever acts independently of the others; God is one! Today we celebrate the Holy Spirit who represents the power of God that raised Jesus from the dead. The Spirit is the guiding force for the church and makes God present to us by the divine indwelling in our hearts. It is also important that we recognize the presence of the Spirit in our own times and our own lives. The Spirit of God is not some vague entity existing in some far-off heaven. The Spirit is God with us, Emmanuel continuing throughout history. The Spirit is ever-present and active throughout all of creation. some theologians speak of the Holy Spirit as the energy force that permeates creation and propels God's plan of salvation forward through history. The Spirit is God at work slowly but steadily drawing all creation (through evolution and other dynamics) toward the fulfillment of God's plan, when "God may be all in all" (1 Cor. 15:28). Fr. Did you know that synthetic fibers — including those from polyester, lycra, nylon and spandex - have been found in alarming amounts in water systems, where they are consumed by aquatic life and even pass on to humans through our consumption of fish and seafood. The fibers, known as "micro waste," get there from humans washing the many, many clothes we wear that contain these synthetic fibers (yes, yoga pants and fleece clothing included). There are options though: try washing such items in a mesh bag (one out there is called the Guppy Friend).
