Yet access to safe drink able water is a basic and universal human right, since it is essential to human survival and, as such, is a condition for the exercise of other human rights. Our world has a grave social debt towards the poor who lack access to drinking water, because they are denied the right to a life consistent with their inalienable dignity." Laudato si #30 "The poor and needy search for water, but there is none; their tongues are parched with thirst. But I the Lord will answer them." Isaiah 41:17

Did you know that 884 million people live without access to safe clean drinking water? Water is a tangible expression of the good news we share. In the developing world, nothing is a better expression of God's love than safe drinking water and the life it offers—nothing, that is, except the love offered to us by Christ. Clean drinking water is good news for the health of children, the lives of women, education of the young, and the economies of the poor.
