### ST. RAPHAEL GREEN CORNER:

Pope Francis writes: "In assessing the environmental impact of any project, concern is usually shown for its

effects on soil and water, yet few careful studies are made of its impact on biodiversity, as if the loss of species or animals and plant groups were of little importance. " LS 35

We are now into gardening season and many of us have begun to plan our gardens and search out plants to enrich our yards and balconies. When choosing new plants for your garden select those with flowers that attract pollinators, such as butterflies and bees. We know the importance of bees for pollination but butterflies contribute greatly too. Butterflies play an important role in pollinating flowers, particularly flowers that have a strong scent, are red or yellow in colour, and produce a large amount of nectar. Nectar is an important component of a butterfly's diet.

The importance of butterfly <u>pollination</u> to plant reproduction may not be equal to that of honeybees, but several plant species, like milkweed and other wildflowers, depend on butterflies to transfer their pollen.

Similar to the process with bees, pollen collects on the butterfly's body as it is feeding on a flower's nectar. As the butterfly moves on to a new flower, it carries the pollen with it. An abundance of butterflies is often an indication that an ecosystem is thriving. Butterflies are an important component of a food chain, both as predators and as prey. Adult butterflies and caterpillars are a source of food for other animals such as bats and hirds

Along with nectar, butterflies eat a variety of plants. Some species also provide a natural form of pest control. For example, the harvester butterfly eats aphids while it is in its caterpillar form.

Consider placing plants in your garden that attract butterflies. You will not only be assisting your backyard ecosystem but you will experience a great deal of joy in watching one of God's beautiful species of creation visit your yard or balcony.
