This week's question: What does it mean that a Christian is a new creation? 2 Corinthians 5:17. The new creation is described in 2 Corinthians 5:17 "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!". The word "therefore" refers us back to verse 14-16 where Paul tells us that all believers have died with Christ and no longer live for themselves.
