

THIRTY-THIRD DAY OF THE LORD IN ORDINARY TIME

Patient endurance will save our lives. By becoming martyrs [witnesses] we will be saved. We Christians are called to martyrdom. That is the challenging part of today's Gospel. We must become witnesses to Jesus Christ.

The world and those who live by its values may appear to be winning. But their victories are hollow, their lives are shallow. Through *patient endurance* of all this and more, you are saving your life.

Lord, I'm trying my best and I don't seem to be getting anything but ridicule. How about that guy next door who never puts you first yet keeps advancing in the world? He makes me look like a fool. When are you going to come to show the world why I suffered?"

Today's gospel is challenging because Jesus demands that we give witness. It is challenging because the Lord demands that we stand up for him, his kingdom and the Christian way of life in a materialistic, self-centered world. It is challenging because it demands that we accept grief from those who mock us. It is challenging because it proclaims that only by patient endurance can we be saved. And the voice of the Lord rings out: "In a little while, a little while longer. But first more need to be added to your number. I am waiting for more people to give witness."
