Earth Poisoning Prevention: Almost half the waste generated worldwide is municipal solid waste, and amounts to 1.3 billion tonnes. One person generates annually waste equal to 7 times their weight. Globally, about one-third of food produced for human consumption is lost or wasted, amounting to about 1.3 billion tonnes every year.

Canadians use between 9- and 15-billion plastic bags a year, enough to circle the Earth more than 55 times, according to the Greener Footprints website. (U.S. citizens use about 100 billion a year!) Few plastic bags are recycled. Most are used for a short time to carry groceries, and then maybe re-used as garbage bags. They take at least 1,000 years to break down, and even then, they don't biodegrade. Plastic shopping bags contain enough embodied petroleum energy to drive a car one kilometer.
