

In 2022, World Habitat Day under the theme "Mind the Gap: Leave No One and Place Behind" looks at the problem of growing inequality and challenges in cities and human settlements, plus it seeks to draw attention to the growing inequalities and vulnerabilities that have been exacerbated by the triple 'C' crises — COVID-19, Climate and Conflict. According to the UN-Habitat's World Cities Report, the number of people affected was between 119 and 124 million in 2020, and between 143 and 163 million in 2021.

Did you know? There are waiting lists for subsidized housing across Ontario. In some areas, the waiting list is **7 to 10 years**. In other places the wait is shorter. Generally, people who have been on the waiting list longer will be offered housing first.

What can I do? Demand that our government representatives, both Municipal, Provincial and Federal, take action to effect change in the supply and the affordability of housing especially for the poor and marginalized!


