ST. RAPHAEL GREEN CORNER World Mission Sunday Pope Francis writes: "Some forms of pollution are part of people's

daily experience. Exposure to atmospheric pollutants produces a broad spectrum of health hazards, especially for the poor, and causes millions of premature deaths." LS #20 "These problems are closely linked to a throwaway culture which affects the excluded just as it quickly reduces things to rubbish." LS#22 "We know that approximately a third of all food produced is discarded, and "whenever food is thrown out it is as if it were stolen from the table of the poor". LS #50 Zero Waste Kitchens: begin with a Zero Waste Grocery Shop! Buy in bulk and avoid overly plastic wrapped, packaged food. Take your own containers (glass bottles such as mason jars, recycled sauce jars, or pickle jars) to bulk good stores and fill them! TAKE Reusable Bags whenever you shop. Recycle all boxboard and paper. Avoid purchasing food in plastic bags and containers as much as possible!

Plan all of your meals (shop with a list) and buy only what you and your family can eat for a meal/week.

Store leftovers in glass containers for lunches or another meal. Freeze leftovers for future meals or for soups and stews. Use reusable containers for packing lunches.

Green Bin any vegetable scraps or food scraps. Use wooden pot scrapers, copper and loofah pot scrubbers.

Wrap lunch items in wax paper or bees wrap! A whole generation of people had their sandwiches wrapped in wax paper over the years!! Refuse, make the choice NOT to generate waste in the first place!
