#### HEROES OF HOLY CROSS: Blessed Basil Moreau CSC

Part 1 of 3: Our holy founder, Blessed Basil Moreau was born in Laigné-en-Belin, in the diocese of Le Mans, France, on Feb. 11, 1799. In 1821, he was ordained a priest for the Diocese of LeMans, and later became a

seminary professor teaching philosophy and theology while enthusiastically continuing pastoral duties. He grew up amidst the turmoil of the French Revolution, and as a young priest he felt compelled to revitalize a Church devastated by years of civil war. With nearly two-thirds of France's clergy and religious exiled or killed, Fr. Moreau organized a group of Auxiliary Priests to preach, teach and bring the message of Christ to those in neglected towns and villages. In 1835, his bishop asked him also to oversee the Brothers of St Joseph, a recently founded group of educators. He merged the priests and the brothers by 1837. This association took its name from the town where it was based, Sainte-Croix, or Holy Cross.
